Dick Cheiny in Stuff Happens, the Professor in The Lesson, Scrooge in A Christmas carol ect. I have done almost anything you can possibly think of as an actor: Films, TV- drama, TV-series, Radio-theatre, Reading novels for the Radio, Teaching, Producing, ETC.

I have tried painting, but found that old used slate from slate roofs was my ideal material. I have success creating stories that matters with brass, lead, mirrors, glue, sand, paint, and ready-mades. I have exhibited in many galleries in Denmark – in Galleria Krabbe in Spain – in Thorshavn on The Faroe Islands, and I am proud of the invitation to be in the European Art Museum.
