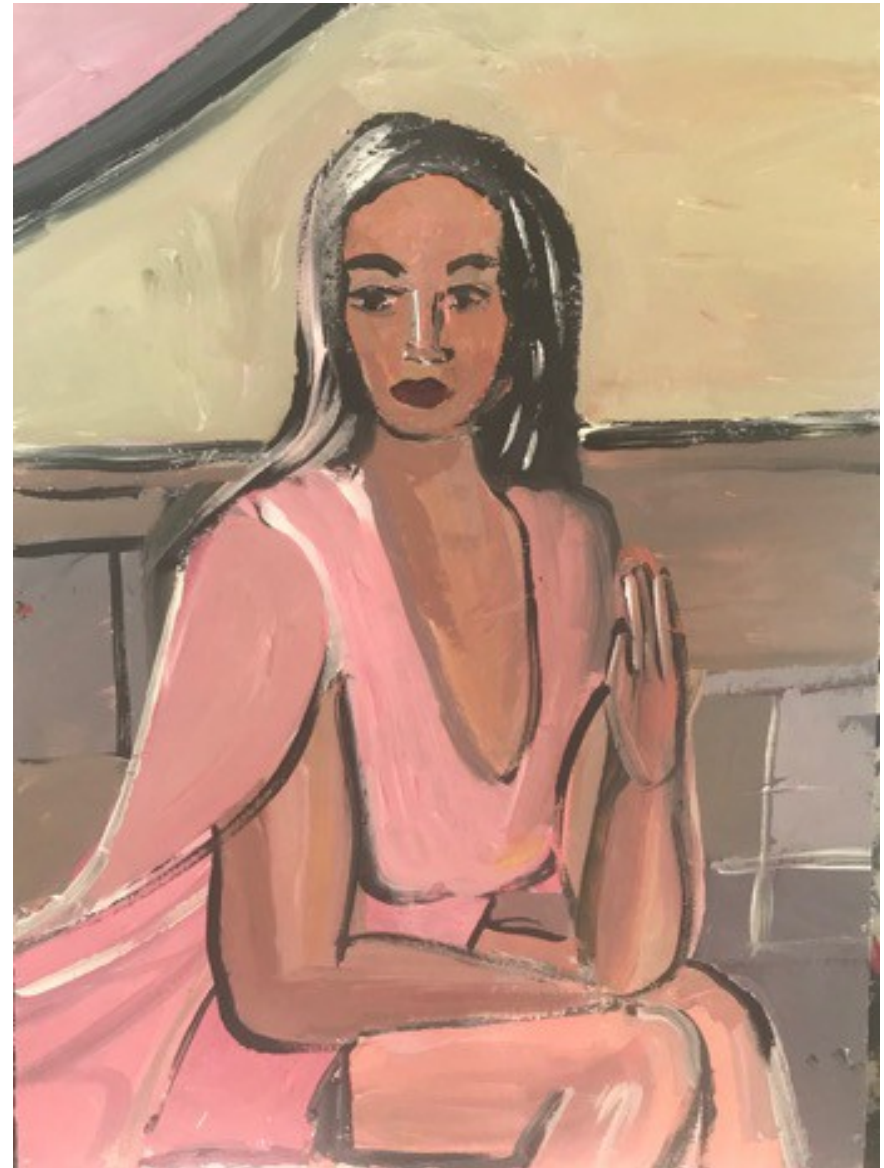
“For over a decade I received painting lessons from an artist and gallery owner. I also learned a lot in dialogue with other artists.”
